Victoria was born in the multicultural city of Odessa, a famous port on the Black Sea coast. The ambience of this charismatic city nurtured a lot of the world's celebrities: the cultures and traditions of 120 nationalities intertwined into an endless source of artistic inspiration.

Victoria's first fragrancerelated entrepreneurship experience started while she was still a University

student - running a small business specializing in distribution of natural essential oils in the Ukraine. Since then Victoria fell in love with the creation of natural scents. Her mother, Dr Iryna Kirichuk (MD), cultivated Victoria's passion towards learning about the significance of the aromas' role and their impact on human health.

Victoria's research laboratory and perfume studio is based at the Puhoi Organic Distillery - boutique business owned by her family. This is the only Distillery in New Zealand producing a special range of unique perfume-grade alcohol and fragrant tinctures. For her bespoke perfume creations, Victoria established direct connections with the best sources of essential oils, absolutes and ambergris. She also uses unique packaging and decorative elements for her perfumes, for example, hand-carved refillable Swamp Kauri bottles and hand-blown glass refillable miniature perfume vials artist-designed as necklaces.

Fragrance-making was Victoria's hobby for many years,
